BYLAW NO. 02-2017

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WOLSELEY IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO
APPOINT BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

The Council of the Town of Wolseley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a. "Council" means the Council of the Town of Wolseley; and
 - b. "Municipality" means the Town of Wolseley.
2. Council hereby appoints Commissionaires South Saskatchewan as the Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence **May 1, 2017** and shall continue until **April 30, 2018**.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officers giving thirty (30) days written notice.
5. The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officers shall be:
 - a. To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the Council of the Municipality;
 - b. To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
 - c. To perform other duties as may be assigned by Council or its delegate.
6. The Commissionaires South Saskatchewan Contract attached hereto shall be titled "Appendix A".
7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on May 1, 2016.
8. Bylaw No. 05-2016 is hereby repealed.
